FILLING OUT YOUR 'APPLICATION TO REGISTER' FORM

(Use FORM A if you are tattooing or use FORM B if you are microchipping)

- Fill in your name, address, prefix and breeder code (tattoo) in the spaces provided
- If you are not the owner or lessee of any of the bucks at the date of service, get the service certificate on the reverse completed by the owner or lessee.
- 'Selected Name' column: enter the <u>name</u> you have chosen for your goat. You do not need to put the prefix in again here. Write on the top line only the second line is for office use, to insert the registration number allocated to the goat.
- 'Date of Birth': enter the date the goat was born.
- 'Tattoo/ID': enter the letters/numbers tattooed in the goat's right and left ear. The right ear tattoo is the Breeder Code. . If you are microchipping and not tattooing, please indicate here with a dash in the space.
- 'Sex': write 'B' for a buck or 'D' for a doe.
- 'No at Birth': enter 1, 2, 3 etc to indicate whether it was a single, twin, triplet.
- 'AI/ET': enter AI if artificial insemination was used, and also complete the service certificate on the reverse. Enter ET if an embryo transplant, and also complete the ET certificates available from the Registrar. Leave blank if neither applies.
- 'Horned/Polled': enter 'H' for horned, 'P' for naturally polled.
- 'Sire': enter the prefix and name of the sire. Use top line for prefix and second line for name.
- 'Registration No': enter the registration number of the sire.
- 'Dam': enter the prefix and name of the dam. Use top line for prefix and second line for name.
- 'Registration No': enter the registration number of the dam.
- "Microchip No": attach bar code sticker over the words "attach bar code sticker here". Only applies if goat is being microchipped, otherwise leave blank.
- If transferring any goats being registered on this form, fill in details on reverse. Note that this is a separate transaction and fee.
- Send the form to the registrar with the appropriate registration fees (and transfer fees if applicable).

Care taken when completing the forms will save time, and keep the registrar happy.
